Registration Process

To register your child(ren) please complete the following by April 15:

1. Enroll with Smart Tuition at www.enrollwithsmart.com
 - a. The non-refundable registration fee is paid online at the time of enrollment with Smart Tuition.
*Registration fee: **\$50 (by March 15th), \$75 (by April 15th), \$100 (after April 15th).**
2. Turn in to the academy office:
 - a. The Family Registration Form (pg. 3)
 - b. The Signed Parent Commitment/Tuition Contract (pg. 4)
 - c. Tuition Assistance Application - If you would like to request financial assistance with your child(ren)'s tuition please contact the school for the application.

Tuition Payments are to be received by first or the 15th of each month with Smart Tuition. Depending on the type of payment plan, you chose.

(Payments made after the due date will be assessed a \$50 late fee.)

PARENT COMMITMENT

****Catholic schools rely on a steady income from parish subsidies, tuition, fundraising, and the work of volunteers in order to continue to provide a high quality education at an affordable cost.****

Therefore, I/we commit to participate in the major required fundraisers that support school operations such as the:

- ***52 Club Raffle (10 tickets per family or buyout of \$100),***
- ***Spaghetti dinner raffle and auction (10 tickets per family or buyout of \$50),***
- ***To purchase Scrip (\$150 profit per family) or buy out for \$150.***
- ***To pay tuition on a regular and timely basis, according to the selected tuition payment plan.***
- ***To volunteer to help at the school, on committees, or with fundraising events whenever possible and at a minimum of 20 hours per school year. I understand that if I/we do not meet the minimum, I/we will be charged \$20 per hour.***

- ***To oversee and encourage homework and good study habits.***
- ***To familiarize myself with the **school handbook and the behavioral, academic, and dress code standards** of the school so as to support the school staff in enforcing these expectations at school, at home, and at school-related activities.***

(Non-Parishioners are exempted from the following but are encouraged to participate in similar ways at their own places of worship.)

Catholic school education serves to support the teaching of the church and the family, working together with them in the faith formation of their children.

Therefore, I /we commit:

- ***To attend weekend and holy day masses with my child/ren.***
- ***To contribute to the life of my parish through stewardship (my time, talent, and treasure).***
- ***To encourage my child/ren to become involved with liturgical ministries such as altar server, cantor, lector, and/or Eucharistic minister at the appropriate age.***
- ***To enroll my child in the parish sacramental program if he/she is in need of preparation to receive the sacraments.***

I /we commit to the above, understanding that faith formation is a **responsibility shared** equally by school, parish, and parents. I will **participate** in all the major fundraisers, **volunteer** my time, **pay** the tuition before the due dates and know that the **commitment and cooperation of parents is vital** to the quality and future of Catholic schools.
