Non-Refundable Registration Fee

\$50 / Family due at the time of enrollment with Smart Tuition, **after March 22 it will charge you \$75, so \$25 will go towards your 1st month tuition payment. After April 23 it will charge you \$100, so \$50 will go towards your 1st month tuition payment.**

Registration Process

To register your child(ren) please complete the following by April 23:

1. Enroll with Smart Tuition at www.enrollwithsmart.com
 - a. The non-refundable registration fee is paid online at the time of enrollment with Smart Tuition.

2. Turn in to the academy office:
 - a. The Family Registration Form (pg. 2)
 - b. The Signed Parent Commitment/Tuition Contract (pg. 3)

Tuition Payments are to be received by first or the 15th of each month with Smart Tuition. Depending on the type of payment plan, you chose. (Payments made after the due date will be assessed a \$50 late fee.)

PARENT COMMITMENT

****Catholic schools rely on a steady income from parish subsidies, tuition, fundraising, and the work of volunteers in order to continue to provide a high quality education at an affordable cost.****

Therefore, I/we commit to participate in the major required fundraisers that support school operations such as the:

- ***52 Club Raffle (5 tickets per family or buyout of \$50),***
- ***Spaghetti dinner raffle and auction (5 tickets per family or buyout of \$25),***
- ***To purchase Scrip (\$75 profit per family will be deducted off this years tuition).***
- ***To pay tuition on a regular and timely basis, according to the selected tuition payment plan.***
- ***To volunteer to help at the school, on committees, or with fundraising events whenever possible and at a minimum of 10 hours for 4K or per school year or 5 hours for Pre-K per school year. I understand that if I/we do not meet the minimum, I/we will be charged \$20 per hour.***

Catholic schools set high behavioral and academic standards for students that can be achieved only with the support and cooperation of parents.

Therefore, I commit:

- ***To send my child/ren to school well-rested and well-nourished.***
- ***To oversee and encourage homework and good study habits.***
- ***To familiarize myself with the school handbook and the behavioral, academic, and dress code standards of the school so as to support the school staff in enforcing these expectations at school, at home, and at school-related activities.***

(Non-Parishioners are exempted from the following but are encouraged to participate in similar ways at their own places of worship.)

Catholic school education serves to support the teaching of the church and the family, working together with them in the faith formation of their children.

Therefore, I /we commit:

- ***To attend weekend and holy day masses with my child/ren.***
- ***To contribute to the life of my parish through stewardship (my time, talent, and treasure).***
- ***To encourage my child/ren to become involved with liturgical ministries such as altar server, cantor, lector, and/or Eucharistic minister at the appropriate age.***
- ***To enroll my child in the parish sacramental program if he/she is in need of preparation to receive the sacraments.***

I /we commit to the above, understanding that faith formation is a responsibility shared equally by school, parish, and parents. I will participate in all the major fundraisers, volunteer my time, pay the tuition before the due dates and know that the commitment and cooperation of parents is vital to the quality and future of Catholic schools.
