



VOLUNTEER HOURS FAQ

From clipping Box Tops at night to coaching a basketball team, each and every one of your volunteer hours is invaluable to not only us by keeping our tuition as low as possible, but to our students who constantly feel at home and surrounded by those they love and grow to love.

WHAT IS THE REQUIREMENT?

Family requirements are based on what grade the oldest child in the academy is enrolled in. *Three-year-old preschool families are required to obtain 5 hours of volunteer work. Four-year-old preschool families must volunteer 10 hours and families with students in any other grade must complete 20 hours.*

HOW DO I LOG MY HOURS?

It is each family's responsibility to log their own hours with the Academy office. This can be done by entering hours in the volunteer/visitor logs located at the front desk in the main office as well as in the preschool Volunteer Log. Families may also email their hours to secretary@jpicatholicacademy.org.

WHAT CAN I DO FOR MY HOURS?

We strongly believe that the best volunteer is one who enjoys whatever job they volunteer for. We have many opportunities throughout the year -- like our Spring Auction, Fall Festival, Christmas Programs, etc. for parents to log hours. We also encourage families to bring any ideas they have to us for volunteer opportunities as well as reach out to their student's teacher for volunteer inspiration. Also, keep checking the weekly family emails for new volunteer opportunities that come available.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T MEET MY OBLIGATION?

Families who do not meet their volunteer hour obligation will be charged \$20 per hour they missed.
